CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **HEBER V. & LORETTA F. HYMAS**
97525
of **1758 Upper River Road, Gold Hill**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the **STATE ENGINEER** of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
a **spring and Rogue River**

a tributary of **Pacific Ocean** for the purpose of
domestic use of one family and stock use

under Permit No. **34937** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from **March 5, 1970**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use from the spring,
and 0.01 c.f.s. for stock use from the spring, with any deficiency in the avail-
able supply from the spring for stock to be made up by appropriation from Rogue *
or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the **Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 10, T. 36 S., R. 3 W.,**
W. M., spring - 1800 feet South and 1180 feet East, river - 580 feet South and
430 feet West, both from W $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and Stock Lot 4 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Stock SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 11
T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

* River provided that the total quantity diverted from both sources shall not exceed
0.01 cubic foot per second.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
