CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That EILERT EILERTSON

of Haines, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Camp Creek, Rock Creek and Rock Creek Lake, tributary of Powder River for the purpose of the irrigation of 31 acres of land, mining and storage of 100 ac.ft.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1905 for 16 acres; 1901 for 15 acres and 1900 for mining and storage

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre for irrigation and 5 cubic feet per second for mining and storage; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decrees

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: 2 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter; 1 acre in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter; 6 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 12 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter and 10 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Eighteen, Township Eight South, Range Thirty-eight East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
