CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **STONE MACHINERY COMPANY**

of P. O. Box 1097, Walla Walla, State of Washington 99362, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of two wells a tributary of Umatilla River for the purpose of irrigation of 314.8 acres and supplemental irrigation of 384.5 acres under Permit No. G-3530 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 24, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 7.40 cubic feet per second, being 3.90 cubic feet per second from Well #1, and 3.50 cubic feet per second from Well #2

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Well #1 - NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 18, Well #2 - SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 6, T. 3 N., R. 28 E., W. M., Well #1 - 1220 feet South and 1760 feet West from NE Corner, Section 18, Well #2 - 80 feet North and 350 feet East from SW Corner, Section 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein the right allowed herein shall not authorize appropriation from the aquifer supplying those wells described in the State Engineer's Ground Water Report No. 11 as "Deep Wells in Basalt", unless appropriations are permitted in the final order of the State * and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
