This Is to Certify, That LORIN H. BICKER

of 801 Claude Street, Enterprise , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of East Branch Wallows River and Reservoir constructed under Application No. R-49375, Permit No. R-5840

a tributary of Wallows River (Grande Ronde River) fish culture and irrigation of 8.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 36082 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon, that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 29, 1972

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.195 cubic foot per second, being 0.02 cubic foot per second for fish culture and 0.175 cubic foot per second for irrigation, provided that no water be diverted for fish culture during the time when water is being diverted for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWk NWk, Section 1, T. 2 S., R. 44 E., W. M., 60 feet North and 590 feet East from the Wk Corner, Section 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5840,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Fish and 8.0 acres SWt NWt Section 1 T. 2 S., R. 44 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
