CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That KIRK HAYES

97846
 of Joseph, State of Oregon, has made proof
 to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
 Wallowa River and Hayes Pond Reservoir constructed under Application No. R-50252,
 Permit No. R-6029
 a tributary of Grande Ronde River for the purpose of
 fish propagation

under Permit No. 37133 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
 confirmed dates from April 3, 1973

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
 aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
 The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, T. 2 S., R. 45 E., W. M.,
 1580 feet North and 1800 feet West from SE Corner, Section 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
 right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second
 per acre,

and shall
 conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
 appurtenant, is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 31
 T. 2 S., R. 45 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
 use herein described.
