of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 20, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid is limited to in amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second, being 0.04 c.f.s. for domestic use and 0.02 c.f.s. for commercial buildings

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 7, (SW2 NE2), Section 11, T. 26 S., R. 3 W.,
W. M., South 39 30' East 1005 feet from the NW Corner, SW2 NE2, Section 11.
