CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. ARLIE BRYANT, INC.

of **802 West Sixth Street, The Dalles**, State of **Oregon**, **97058**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of waste water discharged from East Fork Irrigation District

a tributary of **Columbia River** for the purpose of **pollution abatement for asphalt plant air washing scrubbers**

under Permit No. **36694** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **March 1, 1972**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.25 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄**, as projected within Bensen DLC 37, Section 31, T. 3 N., R. 11 E., W. M., 180 feet North and 160 feet West from SE Corner, NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄, Section 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

The appropriation under this right shall be limited to the water available at the point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water.

_____ and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
