or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW2 SW2, as projected within F.G. Birdseye DIC 37, Section 26, T. 36 S., R. 4 W., W.M., 550 feet North and 70 feet East from SW Corner. Section 26.
