and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291, that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1865 for 80 acres and 1889 for 120 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforegaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree

A description of the lands .. rigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter and Northwest quarter; 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest cuarter of Section Eight, Township Nine South, Range Forty East of Willamette Meridian, in Bakor County, Oregon.
