a tributary of Siltcoos Lake for the purpose of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one-half acre under Permit No. 34232 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 14. 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW4 SE4, Section 23, T. 19 S., R. 12 W., W. M., 1168 feet South and 2513 feet West from E4 Corner, Section 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ______ of one cubic foot per second per acre.
