CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DONALD G. IMSLAND

97857

of **Star Route, Lostine**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Lostine River and Wallowa River**

a tributary of **Grande Ronde River** for the purpose of **irrigation of 77.7 acres**

under Permit No. **33521** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **April 24, 1968**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **1.94 cubic feet per second from Lostine River with any deficiency in the available supply from the Lostine River to be made up by appropriation of not to exceed 1.38 c.f.s. from Wallowa River provided that the total quantity diverted from both ***
or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the **Wallowa River - SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, Lostine River - NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, T. 1 S., R. 43 E., W. M., Wallowa River-1260 feet North and 3170 feet East from SW Corner, Section 11, Lostine River - 530 feet South and 880 feet ****

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fortieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **3 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;**

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**5.7 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
23.8 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
9.4 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
21.1 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
15.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
2.7 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
