CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That ESTATE OF D. FAVORITE, deceased, by E.L. Favorite
 Executor
 of Haines, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
 the waters of Willow Creek and Rock Creek; tributaries of Powder River
 for the purpose of the irrigation of 155.3 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291;
 that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from August 28, 1880 for Tract No. 1
 and 1906 for Tract No. 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot
 per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
 contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appur-
 tenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:
 Tract No. 1 from Rock Creek: 19.5 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast
 quarter; 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 8.5 acres in the
 Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 40 acres in the Northwest quarter of
 Southwest quarter of Section Five, Township Eight South, Range Thirty-nine East of
 Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

Tract No. 2 from Willow Creek: 37.5 acres in the Northeast quarter of North-
 east quarter of Section Seven and 9.8 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest
 quarter of Section Five, Township Eight South, Range Thirty-nine East of Willamette
 Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.
