that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1879 for 120 acres and 1880;
for 80 acres and 1872 for 160 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-four;
