CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That AMOS GARD

of Baker, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Beaver Creek, tributary of Powder River
for the purpose of the irrigation of 45.6 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from January 21, 1873 for 12 acres;
1889 for 26.6 acres and 1898 for 7 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot
per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appur-
tenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

8.5 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 17.9 acres in the
Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter and 19.2 acres in the Northwest quarter
of Southeast quarter, of Section Seventeen, Township Ten South, Range Forty East
of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
