6 at page 291;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dutes from January 21, 1873 for 12 acres;
1889 for 26.6 acres and 1898 for 7 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

8.5 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 17.9 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter and 19.2 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter, of Section Seventeen, Township Ten South, Range Forty East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker Dounty, Oregon.
