CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CURTIS & VERA BENNETT

of 69-161 Victoria Drive, Palm Springs, State of California, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Big Butte Creek

a tributary of Rogue River irrigation of 0.65 acre

for the purpose of

under Permit No. E 168 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 15, 1913

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE% NW%, Section 3, T. 34 S., R. 1 E., W. M., 720 feet West from N% Corner, Section 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.65 acre NEt NWt Section 3 T. 34 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered April 5, 1973, and together with the certificates recorded at page 39597, Volume 31 and page 41601, Volume 33, supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Luke Ryan and recorded at page 38777, Volume 30, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
