## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Central Point , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Bear Creek

a tributary of Rogue River irrigation of 63.1 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 889 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 10. 1911

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.48 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the streum. The point of diversion is located in the SWL SWL, Section 27, T. 36 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

15.6 acres NEt SWt
0.5 acre SEt SWt
12.3 acres NWt SEt
7.2 acres SWt SEt
1.9 acres SEt SEt

An order of the State Engineer entered December 26, 1973, approves a change in place of use for the irrigation of 25.6 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Ralph W. Elden and recorded at page 797, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
