## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HELEN L. HORMEL

of 850 Neil Creek Road, Ashland, State of Oregon 97520, has a right  
to the use of the waters of  
Neil Creek  
a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of  
irrigation of 3.8 acres  
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from 1854

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per  
second

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 30, T. 39 S., R. 2 E., W. M.,  
300 feet South and 1270 feet West from NE Corner, SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 30.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

3.8 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 30  
T. 39 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by  
an order of the State Engineer entered August 8, 1972, and together with the certi-  
ficate recorded at page 38783, Volume 30, supersedes certificate of water right  
heretofore issued to George W. Dunn and recorded at page 15967, Volume 13, State  
Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
