CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **FREDERICK GEORGE FUDGE & HARRY A. SMITH**

of **3886 Winona Road, Grants Pass**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Jump-Off-Joe Creek**

a tributary of **Rogue River** for the purpose of irrigation of **44.9 acres**

under Permit No. **25890** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **October 27, 1958**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.72 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 4, T. 35 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 1250 feet South and 320 feet East from NW Corner, Section 4, 680 feet South and 80 feet East from NW Corner, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fortieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and is subject to a stipulation with the Oregon State Game Commission recorded at page 52 and 53, Volume 4, Miscellaneous Records of the State Engineer,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion and remaining right approved by orders of the State Engineer entered October 31, 1967 and March 12, 1969, and supersedes certificate of water right issued to Frederick George Fudge and recorded at page 30968, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
