CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DARWIN B. & JANE B. VANDERSTELT
97402
of Route 5, Box 1069 T, Eugene, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Fern Ridge Reservoir constructed under Application No. R-29397, Permit No. R-1625

a tributary of Long Tom River for the purpose of
irrigation of 20.8 acres and supplemental irrigation of 51.3 acres

under Permit No. 26681 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from March 18, 1925

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
180.25 acre feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 27, T. 17 S., R. 5 W., W. M.,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second
per acre, a diversion of 2 1/2 acre feet per acre or its equivalent for each acre
irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall be further limited
to a total diversion of not to exceed 180.25 acre feet per year, and is subject
to the terms of Contract No. 14-06-0100-7398, Dated July 11, 1972 between the
United States of America through the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a
copy of which is on file in the office of the State Engineer,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an
order of the State Engineer entered December 12, 1968, and to up-date the Bureau
of Reclamation Contract number, and supersedes certificate of water right issued
to Eugene E. Platt and recorded at page 31374, Volume 23, State Record of Water
Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
