CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOSEPH & JAMES F. HAUN

of Lostine, State of Oregon, 97857, has a right
to the use of the waters of Wallowa River, a tributary of Grande Ronde River, for the purpose of
irrigation of 35.5 acres, domestic, and stock
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 5, at page 171-2; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1889

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed $1\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31 of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, T. 1 S., R. 43 E., W. M., 1260 feet North and 3170 feet East from SW Corner, Section 11.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
14.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
17.5 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

T. 1 S., R. 43 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered August 31, 1970, and together with the certificate recorded at page 37398, Volume 29, supersedes certificate of water right issued to J. F. Haun and recorded at page 3048, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
