CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **ARTHUR J. DONADEI**

of **632 Hawthorne Avenue, Los Altos**, State of **California**, has a right
to the use of the waters of
West Fork Williams Creek
a tributary of _____ for the purpose of
irrigation of 11.19 acres
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the **STATE ENGINEER**, in Volume **4**, at page **1**; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from **1900**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.19 cubic foot per**
second

The point of diversion is located in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$** , Section 8, T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 1840
feet South and 520 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 8.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

11.19 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 8
T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an
order of the State Engineer entered July 9, 1973, and together with the certificate
recorded at page 39598, Volume 31, and supersedes certificate of water right hereto-
fore issued to J. N. Larimore and recorded at page 33247, Volume 25, State Record of
Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
