a tributary of Soap Creek irrigation of 0.5 acre and fire suppression

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 35250 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 17, 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s. for fire suppression

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEZ NEX, as projected within W. Berry DLC 53, Section 9, T. 10 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 3330 feet North and 5890 feet West from SE Corner, Section 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.5 acre and Fire Suppression SEk NEk As projected within W. Berry DLC 53 Section 9 T. 10 S., R. 5 W. W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
