CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OREGON STATE UNIVERSITY

97331
of School of Forestry, Corvallis, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-42671, Permit
No. R-4845
a tributary of Calloway Creek for the purpose of
landscape beautification

under Permit No. 31889 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from August 19, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Reed DLC 57, Section
31, T. 10 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 890 feet South and 930 feet East from W $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner,
Section 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to -----of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
