CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That G. M. GILKISON

of North Powder, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
 the waters of Wolf Creek, tributary of Powder River
 for the purpose of the irrigation of 209.5 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6 at page 291;
 that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1894 for Tract No. 1 and 1879
 for Tract No. 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot
 per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
 contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appur-
 tenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1: 40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter of
 Section Twenty-four: 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter and
 36 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Thirteen, Township
 Six South, Range Thirty-eight: 27.5 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest
 quarter of Section Eighteen and 32 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest
 quarter of Section Nineteen, Township Six South, Range Thirty-nine, All East of
 Willamette Meridian, in Union County, Oregon.

Tract No. 2: 34 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter of
 Section Thirteen, Township Six South, Range Thirty-eight East of Willamette
 Meridian, in Union County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described.
