CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **ROBERT B. PAMPLIN, Jr.**
c/o Miller, Anderson, Nash, Yerke, & Wiener 97204
of 900 SW Fifth Avenue, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
an unnamed creek and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-26590, Permit
No. R-1314
a tributary of Dairy Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 75.3 acres

under Permit No. 21023 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from March 28, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.59 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Horatio
N. Colder DLC 45, Section 26, T. 2 N., R. 3 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be
further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each
acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and
storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1314,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

12.7 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
14.1 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Both as projected within Colder DLC 45
Section 26
25.3 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
10.9 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Both as projected within Colder DLC 45
Section 35
12.3 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
As projected within Colder DLC 45
Section 36
T. 2 N., R. 3 W., W. M.

An order of the State Engineer entered September 30, 1974, canceled the right for
the irrigation of 17.1 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining
right and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Wilfred P.
Grossen and recorded at page 23002, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certi-
ficates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
