## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GENERAL DEVELOPMENT CO. c/o John Day, President 97501 , has sade proof , State of P. O. Box 488. Medford Oregon to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean irrigation of 63.3 acres

for the purpose of

of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. 18531 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 28, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.40 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWI NET, Section 13, T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 42 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is

appurtenant, is as follows:

6.9 acres Lot 4 (SEX SWX) 6.2 acres Lot 4 (SW' SE')
