CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That CHAS. N. GOULD, of Baker, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Beaver Creek and West Fork of Beaver Creek, tributaries of Powder River for the purpose of the irrigation of 62 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6 at page 291 that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1876 for Tract No. 1, 1882 for Tract No. 2, 1905 for Tract No. 3 and 1878 for Tract No. 4

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: Tract No. 1 : 5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter; Tract No. 2 : 6 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter; Tract No. 3 : 5 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; Tract No. 4 : 20 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 6 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter and 20 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter;

All of the above lands are in Section Twenty-seven, Township Ten South, Range Forty East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
