CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN S. & MARY P. DAY
c/o Ben Day 97501
of West Main at Oakdale, Medford, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of
irrigation of 32.9 acres

under Permit No. 18531 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from October 28, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.21 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 18, T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M.,
2350 feet South and 1840 feet West from NE Corner, Section 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to
a diversion of not to exceed $4\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during
the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year;

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

2.2 acres Lot 4 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$)
8.4 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 12
16.1 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
6.2 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 13
T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by
an order of the State Engineer entered April 27, 1970, and together with the certi-
ficates recorded at pages 41769 and 41770, Volume 33, supersedes certificate of
water right heretofore issued to General Development Co. and recorded at page 27274,
Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
