CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOSEPHINE COUNTY 97526
of County Courthouse, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of
irrigation of 3.9 acres and park use

under Permit No. 26326 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from April 29, 1959

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.06 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the Lot 10 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 4, T. 35 S., R. 7 W.
W. M.,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to
a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during
the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of
water is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is 735 cubic feet
per second or more at its mouth,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

3.9 acres and park use Lot 10 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 4
T. 35 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and remaining right approved
by an order of the State Engineer entered May 25, 1970, and supersedes certificate
of water right heretofore issued to Harry A. Wilson, and recorded at page 29524,
Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
