## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** ALBERT N. HANTEN

of Merlin, State of Oregon, 97532, has a right  
to the use of the waters of Taylor Creek  
a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 3.5 acres  
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from 1901

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic foot per  
second

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 7, T. 35 S., R. 7 W., W. M.,  
220 feet South and 750 feet West, 140 feet South and 120 feet West, both from NE  
Corner, Section 7.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

3.5 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 7  
T. 35 S., R. 7 W., W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion and remaining  
right approved by orders of the State Engineer entered June 21, 1967 and December  
12, 1968, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to H. L.  
Lewis and recorded at page 16590, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
