CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CALVIN C. PIKE

of 2639 Cheney Creek Road, Grants Pass, State of Oregon 97526, has a right to the use of the waters of Chaney Creek a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation of 11.0 acres and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from April 11, 1894

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, T. 37 S., R. 7 W., W. M., 480 feet North and 720 feet East, 50 feet North and 370 feet West, both from SW Corner, Section 13.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 13
4.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 14
T. 37 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered April 17, 1970, and supersedes certificate of water right issued to John Lloyd and recorded at page 16275, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
