Willamina Creek, tributary of Yamhill River

public fish facility for the purposes of
 under Reservoir Permit No. **R-768** of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said
 waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right
 hereby confirmed dates from **June 13, 1941**

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes afore-
 said, shall not exceed **20.0 acre feet**
