under Permit No. G-3606 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

June 14, 1967 for West Well and

September 13, 1967 for East Well

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.58 cubic foot per second, being 0.02 c.f.s. from East Well and 0.56 c.f.s. from West Well

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the w. Well-NWk NWk, E. Well-NEK NWk, Section 29, T.

11 S., R. 4 W., W. M., W. Well-840 feet South and 1890 feet West, E. Well-1180 feet
South and 360 feet West. both from Nk Corner. Section 29.

South and 360 feet West, both from Nx Corner, Section 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
