CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MOSER LUMBER COMPANY

of **Kings Valley**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Luckiamite River and reservoir constructed under Application number R-47521, Permit number R-5683**, a tributary of **Willamette River** for the purpose of **manufacturing including fire suppression**

under Permit No. **35346** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **July 6, 1970**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.10 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$** , as projected within Chambers DIC 46, Section 16, T. 10 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 3680 feet North and 3410 feet East from SW Corner, Chambers DIC 46.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
