CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **BYRON & CHARLOTTE POWELL**

97394

of **Bayshore Rt., Box 600, Waldport**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Squaw Creek**

a tributary of **Alsea River** for the purpose of domestic use for one family and commercial use for 20 trailer spaces, 2 cabins, cafe, and boat dock

under Permit No. **35151** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **May 19, 1970**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.04 cubic foot per second, being 0.03 c.f.s. for commercial use and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **Lot 5 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 28, T. 13 S., R. 10 W., W. M., 930 feet South and 1180 feet East from W $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 28.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Lot 5 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 28
T. 13 S., R. 10 W., W. M.**

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
