under Permit No. 34841 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 16, 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **6.0 cubic feet per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (SW2 SE2), Section 11, T. 9 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 350 feet South and 440 feet East from NE Corner, SW2 SE2, Section 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to rof one cable foot per second per acre, the period between March 1 and June 1 of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
