that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic use and 0.01 c.f.s. for stock and dairy facilities

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NW NEX, Section 23, T. 4 S., R. 10 W., W. M.,

200 feet South and 910 feet East from the NX Corner, Section 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ______ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
