CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CLYDE L. & HELEN M. STONEBRINK

of Flora Route, Box 5, Enterprise, State of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring area

a tributary of Trout Creek for the purpose of domestic use for one family, irrigation of 0.3 acre, and stock

under Permit No. 31295 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 21, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic, 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation, and 0.01 c.f.s. for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWk NEk, Section 26, T. 1 S., R. 44 E., W. M., 820 feet North and 410 feet East from SW Corner, NWk NEk, Section 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic, Stock, and 0.3 acre NWk NEW Section 26 T. 1 S., R. 44 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
