## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

FRED B. GRABHORN

of Route 1, Box 844, Beaverton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of reservoir constructed under Application No. R-49470, Permit No. R-6019

a tributary of Tualstin River supplemental irrigation of 73.2 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 37057 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 19, 1972

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 10.5 acre feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW SWk, Section 7, T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 3210 feet South and 280 feet East from NW Corner, Section 12.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with one amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per ours, a diversion of 2½ acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

37.9 acres NEt NEt 35.3 acres SEt NEt Section 12 T. 2 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
