## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ERNEST v. & v. IRENE BEAUDOIN

of 8910 SW 9th Drive, Portland , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unmamed drainage way and reservoir, constructed under Application No. R-44266, Permit No. R-5066 and Beaver Creek

a tributary of Palmer Creek irrigation of 23.6 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 32866 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 17, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.06 cubic foot per second from the unnamed drainage way and reservoir with any deficiency in the available supply from the unnamed drainage way and reservoir to be made up by appropriation from Beaver Creek, provided that the total quantity \* or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (SWt NWt), Section 32, T. 4 S., R. 3 W., W. M., Beaver Creek-280 feet North and 370 feet West, Reservoir-300 feet North and 190 feet West, both from SW Corner, Robinson DLC 52.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5066,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.4 acres Lot 2 (SW1 NW2) 2.0 acres SW1 NW1 As projected within Coovert DLC 57 Section 32 T. 4 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

\* diverted from all sources shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
