of Umpque Star Route, Box 51 D, Oakland , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Calapooya Creek

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 10.4 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 23412 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 3, 1955

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE% SE%, as projected within Stephens DLC 50, Section 15, T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 2130 feet South and 410 feet West from NE Corner, Stephens DLC 50.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.0 acres NET SET

0.4 acre NWT SET

Both as projected within Stephens DLC 50

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered June 11, 1971, and together with the certificate recorded at page 41917, Volume 33, supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Mary K. Forster, and recorded at page 29110, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
