CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JAMES H. FISHER

of 735 Cave Camp Road, Williams, State of Oregon 97544, has a right to the use of the waters of Lone Creek

a tributary of West Fork of Williams Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 23.3 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1901

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.39 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 220 feet North and 50 feet East from SW Corner, Section 8.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8.9 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 6.1 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 8.3 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 8
 T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and remaining right approved by an order of the State Engineer entered November 30, 1970, and supersedes certificate of water right issued to Jefferson Pence and recorded at page 16366, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
