that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.83 cubic foot per second, being 0.73 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.10 c.f.s. for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

40.0 acres SEt NEt 10.0 acres NEt SEt Section 32

8.0 acres NW1 NW1 Section 33 T. 17 S., R. 47 E., W. M.

An order of the State Engineer entered May 24, 1974, canceled the right for the irrigation of 72.0 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to T. J. Brosnan and Jozeph Cooley and recorded at page 2796, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
