CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DAN BUNN

of **Wishram**, State of **Washington** **98673**
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Powers Creek

a tributary of **Abiqua Creek** for the purpose of
irrigation of **9.2 acres**

under Permit No. **20604** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from **July 23, 1951**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.04 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, T. 7 S., R. 1 E., W. M.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to
a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during
the irrigation season of each year;

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

**9.2 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 9
T. 7 S., R. 1 E., W. M.**

Orders of the State Engineer entered February 16, 1968 and April 6, 1970, approved
changes in place of use and point of diversion for the irrigation of 30.8 acres.
This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right and together with the
certificate recorded at page 41940, Volume 33, supersedes certificate heretofore
issued to Bradford A. Edwards and recorded at page 24315, Volume 17, State Record
of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
