that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.41 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEX NWK, Section 12, T. 3 S., R. 26 E., W. M., 2020 feet South and 1580 feet East from NW Corner, Section 12.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other r sit existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-sixtiath** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;
