under Permit No. 34547 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 6, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.50 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NZt SWt, as projected within John Smith DLC 50, Section 8, T. 9 S. R. 5 W., W. M., 430 feet North and 300 feet East from NW Corner, James Smith DLC 56.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ______ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
