CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That W. C. HAWK

of Bay City, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Noyes and Miner Creek and Deer Creek, tributaries of Powder River for the purpose of the irrigation of 108 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1886 for Tract No. 1, 1888 for Tract No. 2 and 1880 for Tract No. 3

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1 from Noyes and Miner Creek: 5 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Sixteen; 10 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter and 20 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Nine, Township Ten South, Range Thirty-eight East of Willamette Meridian

Tract No. 2 from Deer Creek: 23 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter and 20 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Seventeen and 10 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Eight, Township Ten South, Range Thirty-eight East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 3 from Deer Creek: 20 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Seventeen, Township Ten South, Range Thirty-eight East of Willamette Meridian.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
