that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.009 c.f.s. for domestic use and 0.009 c.f.s. for spraying from stream #1 and 0.001 c.f.s. for domestic use and 0.001 c.f.s. for spraying from stream #2

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEX NWZ, as projected within Handley DLC 56, Section 27, T. 3 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 930 feet North and 340 feet West, 820 feet North and 450 feet West from Center Section 27.
