a tributary of Long Tom River irrigation of 139.4 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-4761 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 8, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.56 cubic feet per second, being 0.79 c.f.s. from Well No. 1 and 0.77 c.f.s. from Well No. 2

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW% SE%, as projected within J. Barclay DLC 43, Section 3, T. 14 S., R. 5 W., W. M., \$1-980 feet North and 1220 feet West, \$2-960 feet North and 940 feet West, both from NE Corner, W. Barclay DLC 43.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth. of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 25 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
